Indirect Restorations: Enhanced Aesthetics Using All-Ceramic Treatment Options

Porcelain laminate veneers have revolutionized aesthetic dentistry, allowing the delivery of natural-looking restorations with minimal tooth reduction. Veneers can be used to mask severely discolored substructures while maintaining natural translucency and light transmission. These restorations can be used to literally transform a patient's smile, enhancing his or her overall appearance and sense of self worth.
